The Society

The Archaeological Society of Delaware (ASD), now an active organization of about 100 members, was founded in 1933. At the time, there were no professional archaeologists in the state. By contrast, today, an estimated 25 professionals are employed here full time in government, academia, and private enterprise. The Society laid the foundation for this change, and among its more important accomplishments are the following:

1. Excavated at least nine major and many minor historic and prehistoric archaeological sites.
2. Published the Bulletin of the Archaeological Society of Delaware, as well as several monographs, which provide a permanent record of research in the area.
3. Successfully lobbied for Delaware legislation to (1) protect archaeological sites from vandalism, (2) create an Archaeological Review Board, and (3) hire a professional archaeologist for the State.
4. Raised public awareness of the science of archaeology.

Provenance of the Archives

In 1955, ASD secretary Richard Quick compiled the correspondence and minutes that were available to him into two bound volumes. Also in 1955, Herbert T. Pratt wrote a brief history of the Society (Paper No. 6), and in doing so, discovered that the Society had no more than half of its publications. Over the next twenty years or so, Pratt, acting as unofficial archivist, collected records and publications from older members, former officers and other sources. James and Marianne Akerman, H. Geiger Omwake, Arthur G. Volkman, and Dr. Clinton A. Weslager contributed materials from their collections. Ronald A. Thomas obtained four lots of correspondence from Delaware State Archives; Dr. Allen G. Schiek bought the Archibald Crozier papers at an auction; and Herbert T. Pratt bought some of the early publications from a rare book dealer. Although there are still a few gaps in minutes of meetings, the file of Society publications is now complete. At its October 8, 1994 meeting, the Board of Directors agreed to deposit its archives in Special Collections at Morris Library of the University of Delaware, where they will be available for research. The most recent material (Box 8), was to be retained by the archivist for the present. It and future materials will be deposited at the university annually, or less frequently, depending on the amount accumulated.

Scope and Contents of the Archives

The Society's archives consist of eight boxes of about five linear feet of correspondence, minutes of general meetings, minutes of the Board of Directors' meetings, membership records and directories, financial records, all ASD publications 1933-1996, annual reports of the Eastern States Archaeological Federation which contain annual reports of the Society, and other miscellaneous records. Special collections include correspondence by Dr. Leon DeValinger and Archibald Crozier who were early secretaries, and newspaper publicity about the Society and its members compiled mostly by Arthur G. Volkman.

What appears to have been the last issue (No. 20) was published August 1, 1950.

Inksheds was first published in October 1955. The first issue is not numbered and does not have a masthead. The publication at first was issued five times a year, usually just before public meetings of the Society. In later years, publication was erratic. Issues that were misnumbered, misdated, or not published are cited in the collation. Inksheds was not published between March 1988 and June 1991. Current policy calls for four issues per year in March, June, September, and December.
